Field Tour 2: Lusaka WSC Iolanda Water Works and Treatment Plant

Iolanda Water Works is also situated in Kafue District. It is the largest surface water treatment plant in the country, producing about 190,000m³ of water per day and draws its water from the lower Kafue Basin. The plant supplies water into the heart of Lusaka via a 45km pipeline and over an elevation head of 100m. The visit to the plant will accord participants an opportunity to appreciate the various treatment process and the demanding requirements it takes to ensure residents of Lusaka City have water supplies. The Plant further demonstrate the Government to ensure access to clean and safe drinking water for the city of Lusaka.
